# Recommended Headsets for use with Fast ForWord and Reading Assistant

To receive the full benefit of the Fast ForWord and Reading Assistant programs, stereo headsets with an adjustable microphone are recommended.

## On a computer

We recommend one of the following USB Headsets:

- Microsoft Lifechat LX-3000 available from most computer accessory stores or online (such as <a href="ITSpot.com.au">ITSpot.com.au</a> or <a href="MWave.com.au">MWave.com.au</a>) for \$30 to \$50.
- Logitech USB Headset H390 available from most computer accessory stores or online (such as <a href="ITSpot.com.au">ITSpot.com.au</a> or <a href="MWave.com.au">MWave.com.au</a>) for \$30 to \$50.
- 3. A combination of the Logitech H150 and a USB adapter available online. An online option is:

## On an iPad

We recommend the Logitech H150 and a 3.5mm 4pin to 2x3pin headset splitter adapter - available online. An online option is:

# **Other Options**

#### Apple EarPods on iPad only

If you are using the program on an iPad, in a quiet location, with no background noise (not in a group setting), it is possible to use the Apple EarPod Headphones with Mic as an alternative to the above recommendations.

Cup style stereo headphones with a 3.5mm jack are suitable for the Fast ForWord program only. Please note: students should use an external mouse, not the touch pad on a laptop.
